It acts as a friendly guide for the students which paves the way for greater accomplishments in board exams.

It was built from **old computer materials such as the computer cases to build the body, CD rom to build the hands, and old monitor to replace the face, and cheap electronics, automobile scrap parts and open-source control boards to create its full constitution**.
